During the season our Medic Station hours will be 9am-5pm Monday through Friday and our emergency phone will be manned 24/7.

As a reminder, the Medic Station staffs no doctors who can prescribe medications that are not over-the-counter. Therefore we have no oral or topical antibiotics that can be distributed without a doctor's prescription. We have volunteers and staff capable of assisting patients with minor burns, jelly fish stings, minor rashes and minor suturing.

About ABSAR A.B.S.A.R. is a registered non-profit organization that has been in existence since 1998. Our organization is on call to assist with medical emergencies, marine and aerial search and rescues, as well as with marine based fires. Our two rescue RIBs, located in both English and Jolly Harbours, can be launched within minutes in the event of a callout and our Medic Station in English Harbour is open five days a week to offer medical assistance to the local community. Our organization is run by a group of dedicated volunteers and is funded through donations, corporate Sponsors and our annual membership program.
